The Senate of Final International University, "Final International University Education, Examination and Success Regulation" In accordance with Article 5.2, Final International University makes the following regulations with the approval of the Board of Trustees.

| Short Name | 1. | This regulation is named as " Final International University (FIU) Summer Term Regulation " |
| Purpose and Scope | 2. | This regulation aims to regulate the principles of registration, fee, exam, success and evaluation of summer courses to Final International Final University (FIU). |
| Aims of Summer Term | 3. | <ol style="list-style-type: none">(1) to give students the opportunity to succeed in some of these courses and to enable them to become "regular".(2) to provide successful students with the opportunity to complete the programs they are enrolled in before the normal period. |
| Period | 4. | <ol style="list-style-type: none">(1) The Summer term is opened in the period between Spring and Fall terms. The period of study cannot exceed eight weeks. The beginning of summer term and due dates are included in the university academic calendar.(2) For each course opened in the summer term, the course is made up of the course hours of the normal period. |
| Academic Calendar | 5. | The opening of courses, registration for courses, beginning and ending of courses, examinations and other related matters are carried out according to the academic calendar determined by the Senate. |
| Summer Term Courses and Registration | 6. | <ol style="list-style-type: none">(1) Courses in the normal education programs of the University are opened during the required terms and these courses cannot be postponed in the summer term.(2) The courses to be opened in the summer term are |

determined by the Rectorate upon the recommendation of the related Faculty Dean or School Directorate.

- (3) The minimum number of students required to open courses and/or groups in the summer term is determined by the Rectorate. At the end of registration, the approval of the Rectorate is required in order to open courses that fall below the limit determined by the number of students.
- (4) In the Summer term, based on the Faculty/School Council decision, a student can take 2 or 3 courses subject to not exceeding 12 credit hours.
- (5) The courses that are likely to be opened in the summer term are announced by the rectorate at least two weeks before the beginning of the summer term.
- (6) Students intending to attend the Summer term should pre-register within the period determined by the Rectorate.
- (7) The final registration for courses is made according to "FIU Education, Examination and Success Regulation".
- (8) Students who have fulfilled all requirements of the English Preparatory School, may register in Summer Term courses.
- (9) Students who previously received a (D-), (F), (NG), or (U) grade from a course must register for that course as soon as it is available in the Summer Term. However, graduating students who failed three courses at most and who have the appropriate number of remaining courses during the summer term, in the case of these courses being opened during Summer Term, are given the right of graduation make-up instead of registering for the failed courses.
- (10) In the Summer term, students who are on probation cannot take courses that they have not taken before.
- (11) Students cannot add, drop or withdraw from lessons during Summer Term.

Fees 7. Fees to be paid for the Summer Term courses are not governed by the provisions given under Article 7 of the "FIU Education, Examinations and Success Regulation". The fee to be paid for each credit is announced by the Rectorate at least 2 weeks before the starting date of the Summer term.

Examinations 8. (1) During the summer term, exams are organized within the framework of the principles set out in Article 18 of the "FIU Education, Examinations and Success Regulation".

		(2)	There are no resit examinations for the courses that are opened in the summer term.
Achievement and Evaluation	9.	(1)	The final grades of the courses taken during the summer term are arranged within the framework of the principles of Article 18 of the “FIU Education, Examinations and Success Regulation”.
		(2)	The evaluation weights of the courses given in the summer term are applied in the same way as the weights given in the semester in which the related course is concluded.
		(3)	Courses taken during the Summer School are listed under the heading “Summer Term” in the transcript.
		(4)	Achievements during the Summer School are taken into account in the calculation of the general grade average. However, Summer Term is not considered as an “actual term”.
Regulation On Taking Courses From Higher Education Institutions Other Than FIU	10.		Students can take courses from higher education institutions other than FIU in the summer semester according to the "Regulation On Taking Courses From Higher Education Institutions Other Than FIU".
Other Issues	11.		Any issue not mentioned in these regulations and rules are subject to regulations and rules of “FIU Education, Examinations and Success Regulation”.
Implementation	12.		This regulation is carried out by the FIU Rectorate
Effect	13.		This regulation takes effect from the date approved by the Board of Trustees of Final International University.
